The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) requires that anyone planning to sit for an industrial (N license) examination take and pass a 90-hour Industrial Waste Treatment course.

The course agenda will include:

- Biological treatment regulations
- Domestic wastes and their treatment
- NJDEP rules and regulations governing industrial treatment
- Physical/chemical treatment options
- Industrial waste characteristics and treatment techniques
- Math and calculation reviews
- Plant safety
- Sludge treatment, residuals management and solids handling.

The theory and science behind each topic will be explained and accompanied by examples of practical applications. Several field trips will reinforce the topics discussed in class. The course consists of thirty (30) three-hour sessions which meet from 6:00 to 9:00 pm on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from September 1 through December 22, 2009.
