At 4-way stop make left onto Dudley Road
Follow Dudley Road to end and make right onto Nichol Avenue
Follow Nichol Avenue, passing 2 sets of greenhouses
Make next right onto Lipman Drive (one-way street at bookstore)
The Douglass Parking deck will be on your left
Follow path at end of parking deck to right (opposite end you drove in)
Take footbridge to left (Hickman Hall at end of bridge)

From Garden State Parkway

From South: Exit 129 (NJ Turnpike)
Take NJ Turnpike South to Exit 9
Follow directions above from this point
For North: Exit 130 (Route 1 South)
Follow Route 1 South (over Raritan River)
Once over river take fourth exit (College Farm Road)
Follow directions above starting with #6

From Route 1 South

Take Route 1 North past intersection of Route 130
Take first exit past Devry Institute (College Farm Road & Squibb Drive)
Exit will U-turn under Route 1 (follow U-turn)
End of U-turn at Stop sign make left (College Farm Road)
Follow directions above starting with #6

From Route 287

From North: Take Route 287 South to Exit 9 (River Road/Route 18)
End of Exit ramp make right onto River Road
Follow River Road to Junction of Route 18
Make right onto entrance ramp for Route 18 South
Follow Route 18 to Junction of Route 1 South (past second light)
Take exit for Route 1 South
Follow directions above starting with #4
