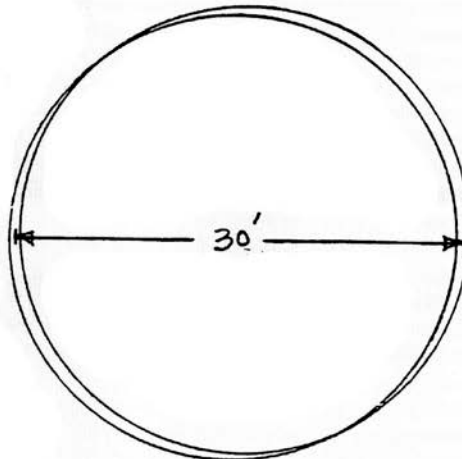
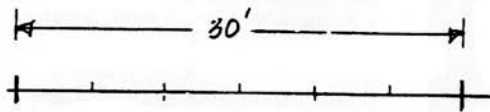
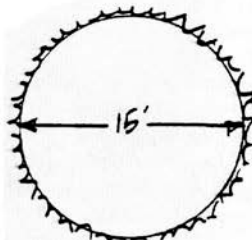
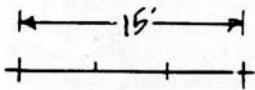


SIZES TO DRAW PLANTS

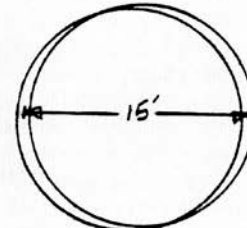

Shade or canopy tree

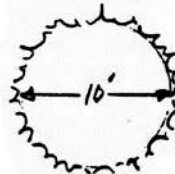
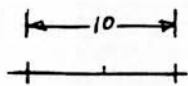

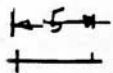
ORNAMENTAL TREES
