- Choose plants that require similar water and light requirements

- Containers are often overplanted
- If planting one type pot, consider grouping pots together

Slow Release Fertilizer

- Absorbed by plant throughout season
- Can last up to 4-6 months

Water Soluble Fertilizer

- Dissolves in water
- Available to plant when water is applied and absorbed by plant
- Needs to be applied every 10-14 days
