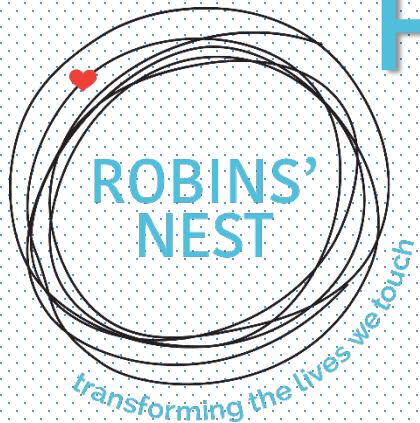


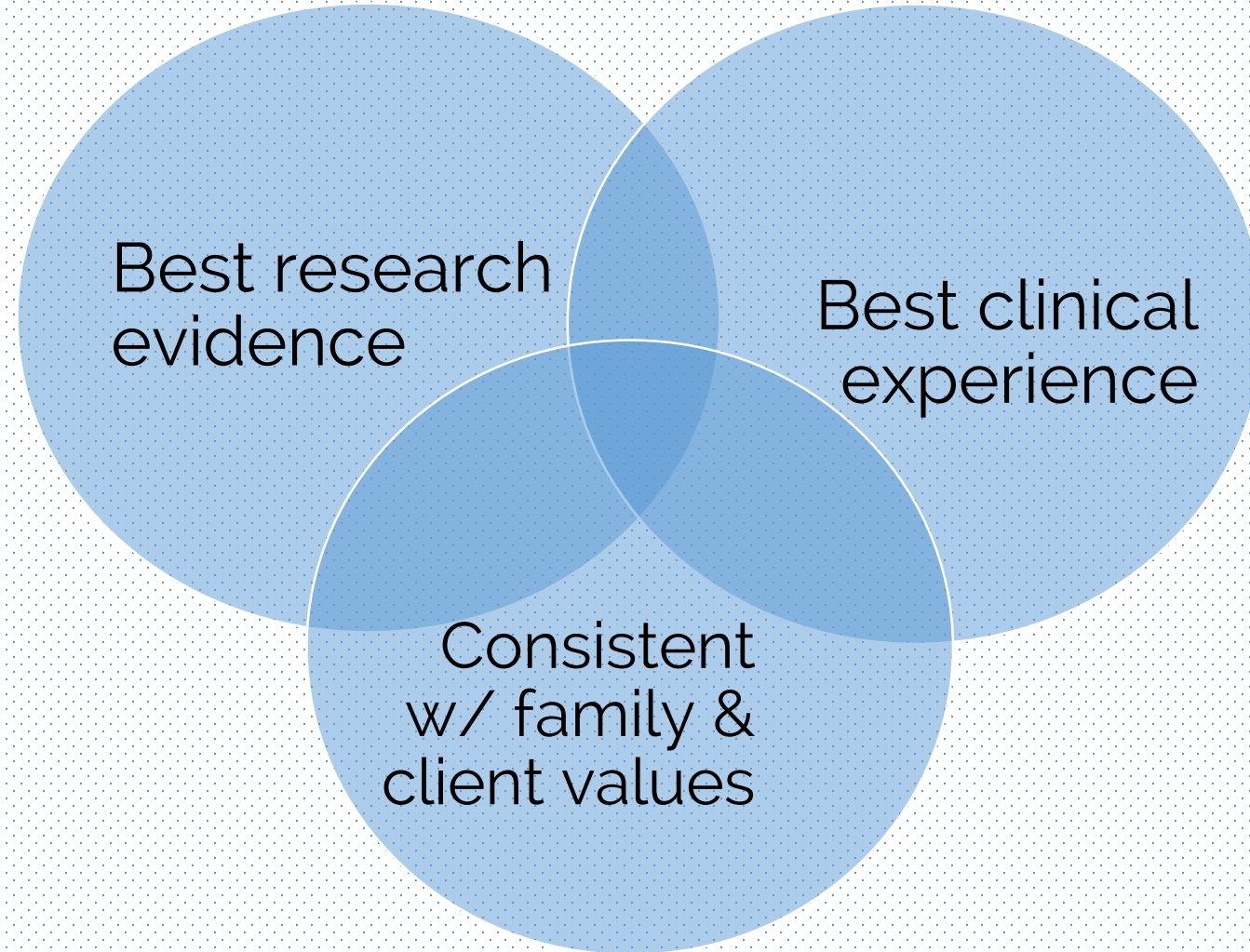

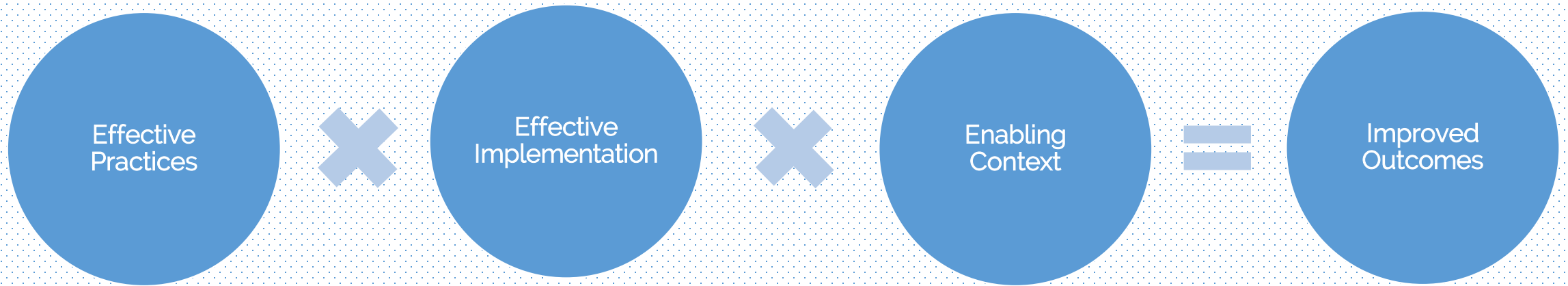

CEBC's Definition of EBP for Child Welfare

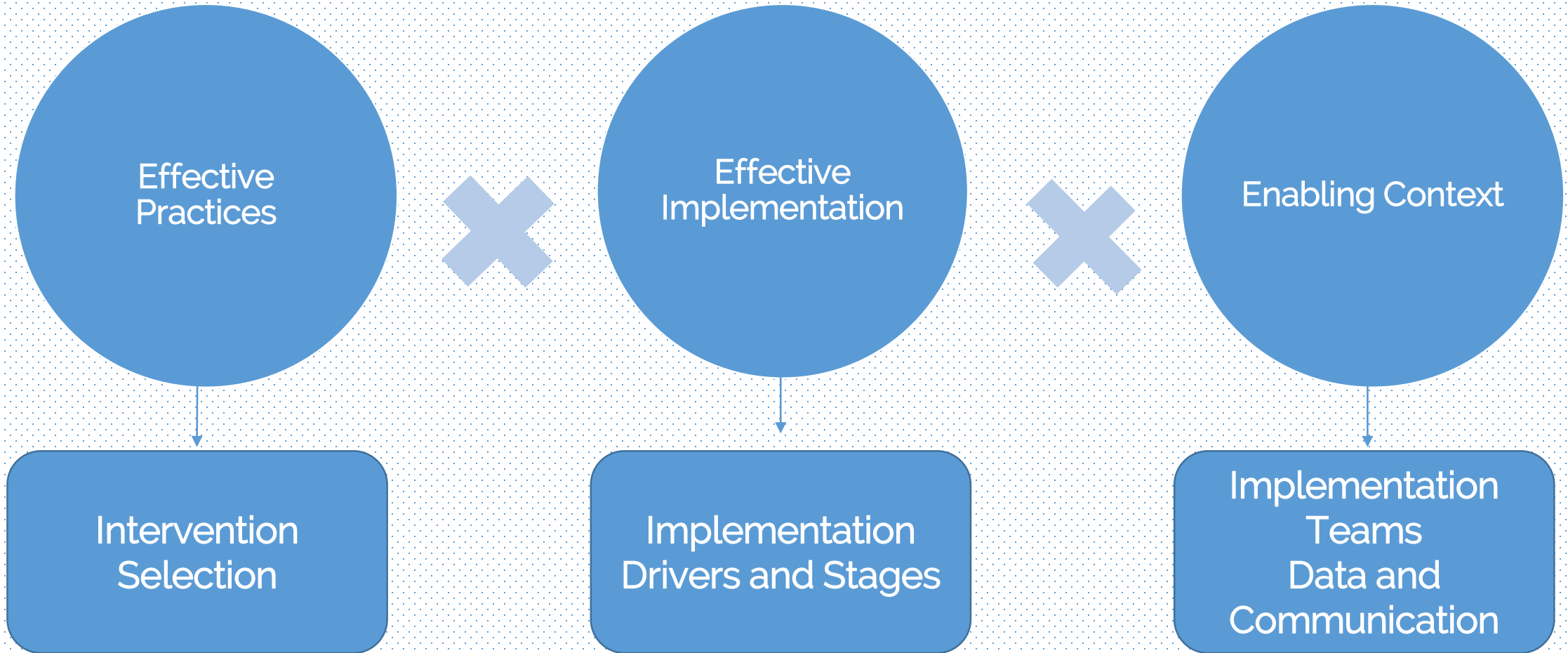


EBP Implementation Science Framework

- Training and Coaching

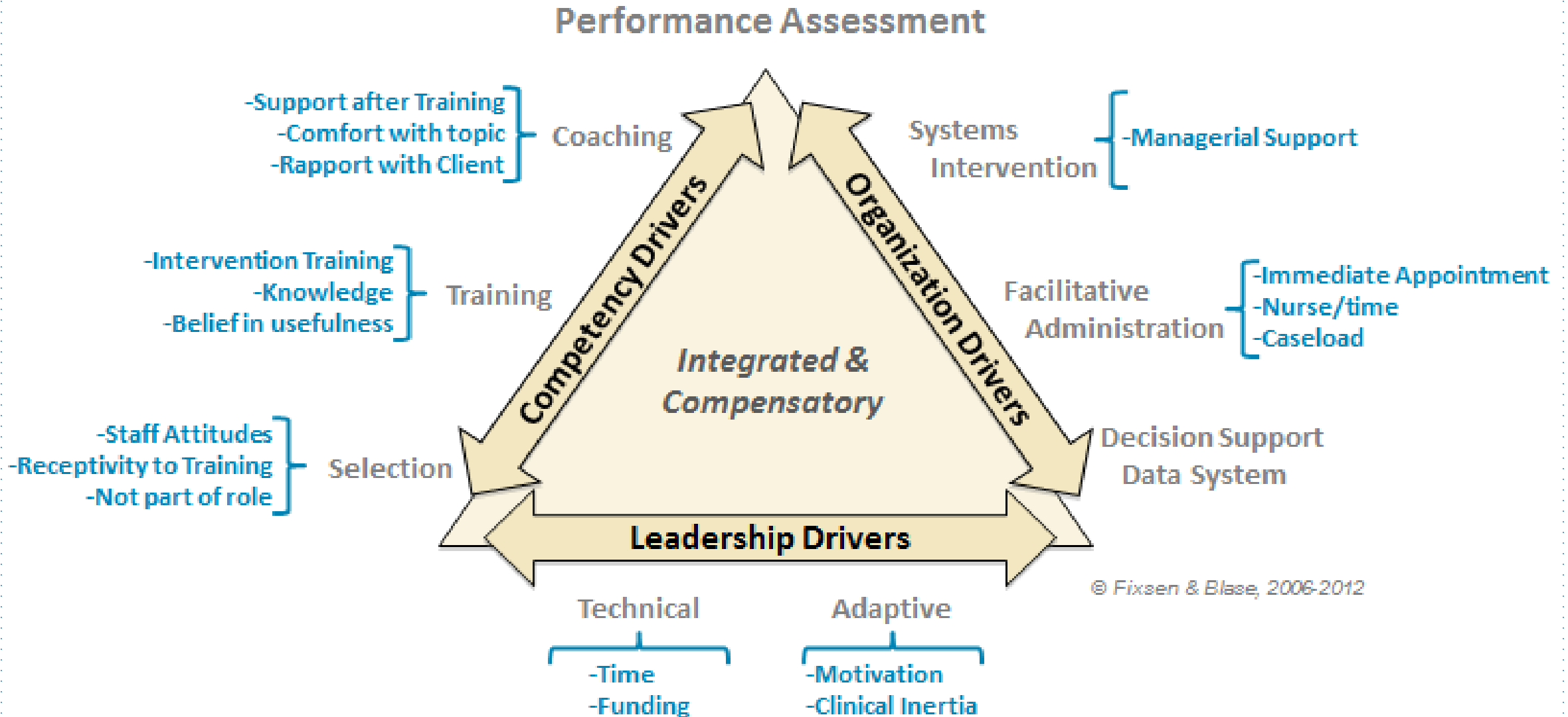
Implementation Phase

- Outcomes

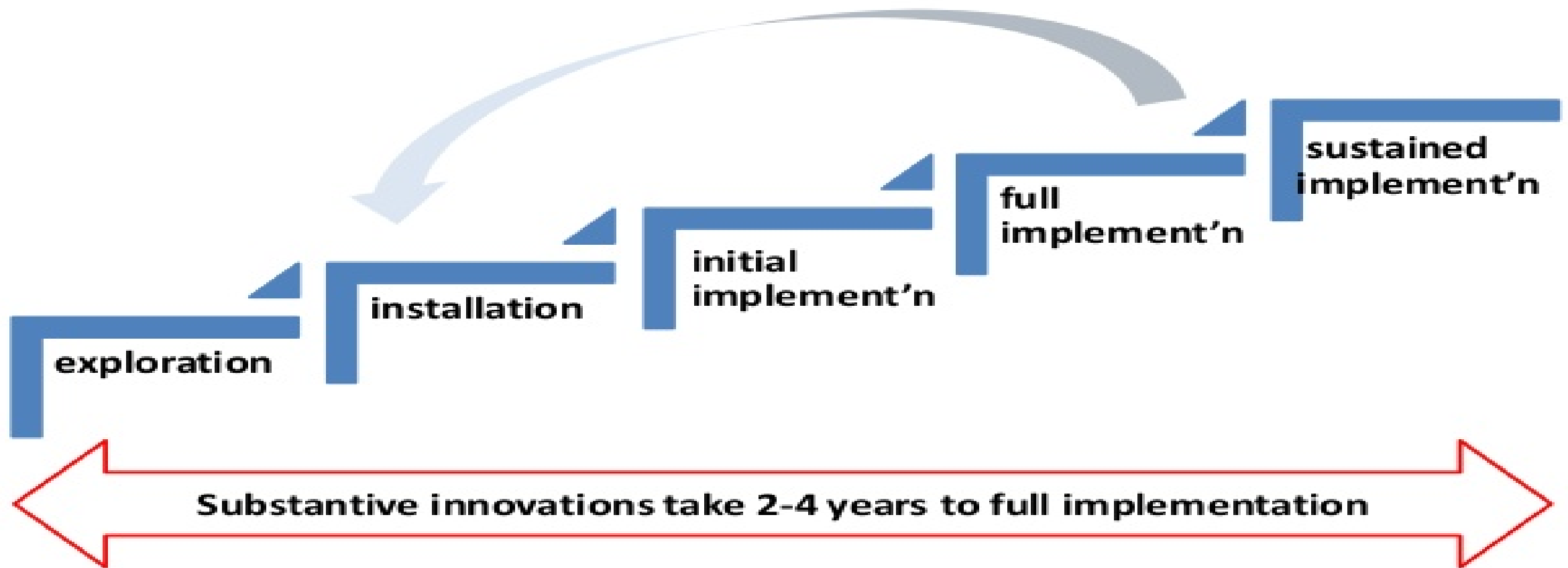
Sustainment Phase
